The parcels of wine in the The Maitre D' come from the McLaren Vale grapes from the red soils of our Coppermine Rd block, harvested on 29th March and from our Long Gully Rd block, harvested on 5th April. They give richness and substance. We blended them with the exquisite fragrant Cabernet we made from Darren and Belinda Joppich's block in Langhorne Creek which we harvested on the 28th March.

Dark, dense and mildly chewy, bursting with black coffee-accented blackberry and black cherry flavors, persisting on the expressive, ripe finish. Drink now through 2020. *Harvey Steiman, Wine Spectator*

Deep garnet-purple in color, the 2012 The Maitre D' Cabernet Sauvignon presents aromas of blackcurrant cordial, blackberry preserves and cloves with hints of baking spices and vanilla. Very big and very full, the palate is a little compacted though offers great richness framed by low to medium level chewy tannins and a long finish.
