2013 Tech Sheet

The grapes for The Scooter come from McLaren Vale – from our own sustainable Long Gully Road block and the biodynamic Gemtree Vineyards. Gemtree have grown for us for 10 years using our Vineyard Watering Program. We use 90% American and 10% French oak when fermenting and maturing wine. It has developed a lovely silky texture and velvety tannins.

Marquis Fruit Weight™ is the percentage of your palate (from the tip of your tongue going all the way back) that's covered by the velvety sensation of fruit, before you experience any of the structural components of the wine.

Winemaker's tasting notes

A Merlot with brilliant red colour and a fragrant cherry and plum nose, mouth filling berry fruit on the palette with mocha and spice lingering along the tongue. The 2013 Scooter has racy acid that really brightens the fruit, a vibrant and perfumed wine with great plummy intensity. The tannins are soft and supple while the subtle oak compliments the abundant fruit. Balanced yet expressive the Scooter is joyous and enjoyable. *Matt Walker-Brown*
